



Information about Psychological and Neuropsychological Testing:

CREEKVIEW ASSESSMENT CENTER, PA provides comprehensive psychological and neuropsychological assessments. Our evaluations are personalized, designed to answer diagnostic questions and focused on in-depth understanding of you or your child's concerns. Typically, this type of assessment goes beyond what most insurance companies regard as medically necessary. This means that what we provide typically is not covered by your insurance. Our goal is to gather enough information to provide you with an accurate and useful summation of our findings and recommendations for treatment. We believe this to be worth some financial investment and commit our best professional efforts in helping you obtain what you need. Please note the following:

- **Our testing fees vary and are based on the nature and scope of the evaluation.** Our general fee for Psychological Evaluations, ADHD/Learning Disability evaluations, Neuropsychological Testing and/or Neurodevelopmental Assessment is between \$2,500.00 and \$4,500.00. The cost of other specific types of assessments is typically less. Forensic Evaluations may cost considerably more. There is a \$200 fee for the initial intake appointment, payable at the time of service. Half the estimated cost of the assessment is due at the first testing appointment. The balance is due at the feedback meeting. No reports will be released until payment is received in full for the assessment.
- Please be aware that your contract with us for our services is between yourself and Creekview Assessment Center, PA, and not between us and your insurance company. **Creekview Assessment Center, PA is not contracted with any insurance company which means that we set our own rate and the number of hours needed for the services that we provide you.** Our standard rate is \$200.00 per hour for routine Psychological Testing, \$225 per hour for specialized psychological testing and \$275.00 for Neuropsychological Testing.
- **It is our policy to discuss payment for an evaluation with you in advance of testing.** Based on the preliminary information obtained during the clinical intake meeting we will discuss the total estimated cost of the evaluation with you prior to commencing with the assessment.
- **This initial amount can be approximately between \$600 and \$2,000 dollars depending on the type and scope of the assessment. This covers the testing materials fee of \$250.00. The balance covers the appointments to conduct the testing. If you fail to show for your appointment or fail to give 48-hour notice that you are unable to attend, you will be charged for the hours set aside for that appointment at \$200 per hour.** The exception is in the case of illness or family emergency. The estimated balance for the complete assessment is due at the feedback meeting to discuss the assessment results and no reports will be released prior to payment in full.
- **Payment in full of the estimated total cost for evaluations that will be used for forensic purposes, and/or Independent Educational evaluations, is required at the time of the first testing appointment.** Any overage payments will be reimbursed.

- **Certain services that we might provide may not be included in the overall estimate such as** consultation with other professionals, extensive review of prior records, collateral interviews, or for clerical services such as phone calls, writing letters on your behalf, etc. These may incur additional costs. We have a fee schedule for such costs.
- Should additional services or the scope of an assessment be extended, and/or estimated fees need to be changed, fair notice will be given to you.
- The forms of payment we accept are payments from HSA accounts, credit cards and cash or check. **We charge an additional 5% per credit card transaction to cover processing fees.** We reserve the right to utilize a collection agency for outstanding balances not paid in full within 30 days of when the assessment is completed if no payment arrangement has been made. **Accounts that go unpaid beyond 30 days will accrue 5% monthly interest.**
- Please discuss any concerns that you might have about payment with your assigned clinician as soon as they arise.
- **Dr, Turley and the assessment team at Creekview Psychological Assessment Center, PA** strive to provide the highest professional standards of best practice. We consider the services we provide to be clinically relevant and critical to inform treatment, but they may not be considered medically necessary by the exclusionary policies of your insurance company.
- It is important that you understand that we cannot negotiate coverage with your insurance policy for our services.
- **We can provide you with a statement (superbill) of your account and a receipt upon request once the assessment is complete and all payments have been received and have been processed.**

PLEASE NOTE:

Even if your insurance company tells you that you have insurance that covers psychological testing this may not be the case. Insurance policies have very specific guidelines about what they deem medically necessary regarding psychological and neuropsychological testing.

Creekview Assessment Center is not contracted with any insurance companies and do not accept third party payment.
